1. BLACKBUSHE APPRAL The Inquiry into the appeal by ADT starts on August 18th for a maximum of 3 days. With only 8 days to go amended plans by ADT have been made public.

ADT have deleted a sunken car park in which vehicles for sale would be hidden, and have applied for a ground level park in which the vehicles would be fully visible. They have also asked for a substantial new diversion of the Welsh Drive to make way for the car The car park application, and the enforcement of the order banning illegal park. parking on the Common will form the Inquiry agenda.

The Yateley Society will protest against the car park application, and argue that the Inquiry should be stopped because it is a new planning application and not just an amendment; and will contest the Welsh Drive diversion.

Your support is needed at Fleet on August 18th (and other days if necessary), every name in the attendance book strengthens our case, show that you support Yateley!.

Camberley Kart Club will shortly be submitting Application No. HDC/21916 - to be published in the "Courier" with the required Hart D.C. notice.

The Kart Club will be applying for: Permanent use of the Kart Racing Circuit, outbuildings and Portakabins.

(The number of hours of use/meetings per year will be made known with the application.) Points to note are:

- 1) The track is right next to the Castle Bottom SSSI. The Go-Karting inevitably attracts unauthorised activities such as motorcycling which seriously damages the SSSI.
- 2) Damage is caused casually and probably unintentionally by Kart spectators who are unaware of the significance and value of Castle Bottom.
- 3) Hampshire C.C. have bought Castle Bottom because they appreciate its importance.
- 4) Increased building since the Kart track was first used means that more people live nearer to it, and the noise nuisance can longer be tolerated.

Please, write to protest when the application is publicised in the "Courier".

If this is not stopped a) Castle Bottom will suffer irreparable damage.

b) The noise nuisance is now a "material consideration" to the decision on the Application.
